Crislove A. Igeleke is a Deputy City Attorney for the City of Las Vegas where she was born and raised. She currently focuses on transactional law and real estate redevelopment. Crislove serves on the Las Vegas Chapter of the Las Vegas National Bar Association Executive Board for the 2021-2023 term and previously chaired the Community Partnership and Voter Initiatives for the organization.

Crislove earned her bachelor's degree in Political Science and International Relations, Magna Cum Laude from Lincoln University (PA). Thereafter, Crislove served as an educator in the Clark County School District before entering law school. During law school, she worked in the Thomas & Mack Legal Clinic, and as a research assistant, and an education advocate for student with special needs. Prior to joining the City Attorney's Office, Crislove worked for a civil litigation firm defending companies in a broad array of matters stemming from premise liability, tort actions, contract disputes, trademark, and malpractice claims. She has represented clients from national franchises, corporations, and TV personalities to nonprofits, small business startups and individuals at the prelitigation, arbitration and trial preparation stages.
